



## **Hestia**

In Greek mythology Hestia is ‘the keeper of the hearth’, the goddess who keeps the home fires burning.

This luxurious wrap is made with lightweight, 100% Alpaca yarn, from Fibre Friends, on Vancouver Island, in Canada.

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

46 cm. X 203 cm. (18” X 80”)

### **MATERIALS**

Approx. 360 grams sportweight, 100% Alpaca Yarn  
Shown in Natural Dark Brown

1 - 3.25 mm circular needle

### **GAUGE**

26 sts = 10 cm in pattern stitch

### **PATTERN**

Cast on 90 stitches using your preferred cast on method.

Work 6 rows in garter stitch then begin lace pattern:

Row 1: k3, \* yo, k2, k2 tog, k2\* repeat from \* to \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2 and 4: k3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3: k3, \* k2, k2 tog, k2, yo\* repeat from \* to \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Continue this pattern until desired length is reached, ending with Row 4.

Work 6 rows in garter stitch.

Bind off loosely.

### **FINISHING**

Block thoroughly.
